# **EVACUATION PROCEDURES**

## Continuous ringing of the siren-go to the Primary Oval

- 1. Give clear instructions to students
- 2. Line everyone up at the exit
- 3. Leave through allocated emergency exit
- 4. Assemble your class on the Primary Oval in single file
- 5. Access roll (electronically or hard copy)
- 6. Call class roll and alert leadership as to 'child missing or all present'

# SHELTER IN PLACE PROCEDURE

### Short blasts of the siren for at least two minutes

- 1. Go or stay in nearest supervised classroom
- 2. Lock doors, lights off & blinds down
- 3. Ensure you have a device to access MS Teams
- 4. Sit quietly on the floor under tables
- 5. Leadership will make contact via MS Teams of code status
- 6. Access roll (electronically or hard copy)
- Call class roll and alert leadership via MS Teams original alert message as to 'child missing or all present'
  - Wait for the all-clear siren- one long blast and message via MS Teams

## Yard Play- Recess/Lunch time

- 1. Go to the nearest 'Safety Zone Area'
- 2. Teacher on Duty will proceed to the nearest safety zone to supervise
- 3. All teachers to go to nearest safety zone to assist

### **WHAT BELL IS WHAT?**

Short blasts SHELTER IN PLACE

Continuous Siren EVACUATION

One Long Blast ALL CLEAR

3 RINGS - INCLEMENT WEATHER-Students in classrooms

1 RING – Students out to play as weather has cleared

## PBC (Lockdown)

Precautionary Building Confinement Notified if Code Red or Code Yellow

### **Code Red**

PBC Lockdown: students remain under tables

Danger outside

### **Code Yellow**

Shelter in Place: students come out from under tables and remain in room

Fumes, stray dog, child, storm.

### Safety Zone Area

Area where students invacuate during recess or lunch. Yellow sign displayed.

Teachers communicate via
MS Teams

### **Code Purple**

#### **BOMB THREAT**

Follow evacuation procedure

Maintain MS Teams contact

Students to be guided to oval or offsite
